

The international conference European Values in the Charter of Fundamental Rights offers a multidisciplinary debate on the values of Dignity, Freedoms, Equality, Solidarity, Citizens' Rights, and Justice, as expressed in the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights. A final session will be dedicated to Gender Equality in research and policies, with specific concern to migrations.

Some internationally distinguished scholars will present their own view on how those values should be understood in the context of the European project. Such reflections assume a particular meaning in the context of the contemporary migration and refugee crisis, that challenges EU normative standards.

The conference is organized as part of the European research project **NoVAMIGRA** – Norms and Values in the European Migration and Refugee Crisis.

NoVAMIGRA is based on the assumption that the future of the European project depends also on EU's capability to realize conditions of legitimacy and justice within its borders and beyond, and to fulfil its global responsibilities.

- providing a comprehensive understanding of the core European values/norms;
- explaining how these values/norms motivate and/or affect relevant political, administrative, and societal agents with regard to migration and the integration of migrants and refugees into European societies;
- studying, whether, how, and why these values/norms have been changing as a consequence of the refugee crisis since 2015; and
- developing a rights-based democratic perspective for the EU and its Member States, which takes into account differences in European values/norms that became visible during the refugee crisis, but also reflects Europe's global responsibility.

The **NoVAMIGRA** project devotes particular attention to gender issues.
